4.1 Reservation for Backward class Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State are as per the details shown in table below. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats) which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority in the Government/Government Aided/University Department /Managed institutes/ Unaided Non-Minority Institutions. In Unaided Minority Institutes, there is no reservation for backward class category candidates; however reservation for backward class candidates can be implemented under CAP provided that the management of the institute gives the written consent.

Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong at the time of submission of CAP application form for Admission. These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit.

Candidates belonging to **Special Backward Class (SBC)** will be offered reservation up to 2% of the seats, available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats), which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority subject to **condition that seat remain vacant in the reserved category at the end of stage–I of allotment logic.** These seats are carved out during the allotment of stage-I and no separate seats are earmarked before the start of the allotment process. **SBC** Candidates having original category OBC will be considered at par with OBC Candidates.

4.1.1 All the candidates claiming the reservation for backward classes should submit "Caste certificate" in the name of the candidate issued by the Executive Magistrate/Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra State clearly mentioning the Category of the candidate and also the remark that the caste is recognised as backward class category belonging to the State of Maharashtra at <u>the time of submission</u> of CAP application form for the Admission to MBA/MMS/PGDBM course.

4.1.2 The candidates belonging to SC, VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce **"Caste Validity Certificate"** issued by Scrutiny Committee of Social Welfare Department and the Candidate belonging to ST category should submit **"Tribe Validity Certificate"** issued by Scrutiny Committee of Tribal Department at <u>the time of verification of documents</u> for the Admission. The policy of Social Justice and Special Assistance Department and Tribal Development Department of State Government will be made applicable in case of Caste/ Tribe Validity Certificate.

4.1.3 The candidates belonging to VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce "Non Creamy layer Certificate" issued by Sub Divisional Officer / Deputy Collector of the district in addition to the caste certificate at <u>the time of verification of documents</u> for the Admission. The "Non Creamy layer Certificate" should be valid upto 31st March 2015. if these candidates are not able to produce the Non Creamy layer certificate at the time of submission of CAP application form for the Admission, then such candidates will be treated as GENERAL category candidates and such candidates will not be able to claim Reserved seats in the admission process.

4.1 The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State are as per the details shown in table below. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats) which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority in the Government/Government Aided/University Department /Managed institutes/ Unaided Non-Minority Institutions. In Unaided Minority Institutes, there is no reservation for backward class category candidates; however reservation for backward class candidates can be implemented under CAP provided that the management of the institute gives the written consent.

Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong at the time of submission of CAP application form for Admission. These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit.

Candidates belonging to **Special Backward Class (SBC)** will be offered reservation up to 2% of the seats, available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats), which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority subject to **condition that seat remain vacant in the reserved category at the end of stage–I of allotment logic.** These seats are carved out during the allotment of stage-I and no separate seats are earmarked before the start of the allotment process. **SBC** Candidates having original category OBC will be considered at par with OBC Candidates.

4.1.1 All the candidates claiming the reservation for backward classes should submit "Caste certificate" in the name of the candidate issued by the Executive Magistrate/Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra State clearly mentioning the Category of the candidate and also the remark that the caste is recognised as backward class category belonging to the State of Maharashtra at <u>the time of submission</u> of CAP application form for the Admission to MBA/MMS/PGDBM course.

4.1.2 The candidates belonging to SC, VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce **"Caste Validity Certificate"** issued by Scrutiny Committee of Social Welfare Department and the Candidate belonging to ST category should submit **"Tribe Validity Certificate"** issued by Scrutiny Committee of Tribal Department at <u>the time of verification of documents</u> for the Admission. The policy of Social Justice and Special Assistance Department and Tribal Development Department of State Government will be made applicable in case of Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate.

4.1.3 The candidates belonging to VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce "**Non Creamy layer Certificate**" issued by Sub Divisional Officer / Deputy Collector of the district in addition to the caste certificate at <u>the time of verification of documents</u> for the Admission. The "**Non Creamy layer Certificate**" should be valid upto **31**st March **2016**. if these candidates are not able to produce the Non Creamy Layer certificate at the time of submission of CAP application form for the Admission, then such candidates will be treated as GENERAL category candidates and such candidates will not be able to claim Reserved seats in the admission process.

4.1.4 Seats under reserved category in MS seats are to be offered to the Backward Class candidates belonging to the Maharashtra state only and no OMS candidate belonging to Backward Class will be admitted against these seats. *If the Candidate is migrated from other state and got the migrated caste certificate then such candidates will not be considered for the benefit of the reservation, such candidate will be considered as General Candidate.*

4.1.5 In case of Reservation for Maratha Candidates any amendments/Acts/Judgments which may be published by Government/Hon. Courts of India from time to time will be applicable to Candidates and Institutes covered under these rules of admission

4.2 Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidates :

As per the provisions in **Clause 39 of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act, 1995**, three (3) per cent seats of total sanctioned intake capacity <u>of all the institutes</u> shall be reserved for Persons with Disability candidates. *These seats shall be within the sanctioned intake of the institute and reserved only for Maharashtra State Candidates having type A and B as mentioned in Table of rule 3.1.*

Out of the three percent reservation for Persons with Disability candidates:

- **PH-1**: Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1)
- PH-2 : Speech & hearing impaired (dumb and deaf) candidates, (P2)
- **PH-3:** Candidates with orthopedic disorders and learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3).

Certificate required: The candidate shall produce a certificate, in the prescribed proforma, "F", from the Director, All India Institute of Physically Handicapped, Mumbai **or** Dean/Civil Surgeon of **the**

(c) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake of all the Institutions under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates with Disability.

- (i) 1% seats for Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1),
- (ii) 1% seats for Speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates (P2),

(b) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake of all the Institutions under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates with Disability.

- (i) 1% seats for Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1),
- (ii) 1% seats for Speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates (P2),
- (iii) 1% seats for Orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3)

The allotment of seats reserved for the Candidates with Disability shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit of respective type of handicap of such candidates. These seats are available in Home University (HU) / State Level (SL) seats for Maharashtra domiciled candidates. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma-F/F-1.

Note:-

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to postgraduate degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities. (ii) Eligible Maharashtra State Candidates having their parent's annual income less than Rs.6.00 Lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for these seats. The candidate shall submit Income certificate issued by Appropriate Authority.

(III) Admissions Procedure

These seats are allotted by the Competent Authority as per inter-se merit. For this purpose, the Competent Authority shall invite applications, prepare a separate merit list for this category by following the same criteria as for Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates. In the event of non-availability of students in this category the same shall not be given to any other category of applicants.

(d) Jammu and Kashmir Candidates and North East States:

- (i) The admission to the candidates as per Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) for the students belonging to Jammu and Kashmir and the scheme of Government of India of allocation of supernumerary seats in AICTE approved colleges to North Eastern States and UTs (NEUT) which lack in such facilities of technical education shall be done by the competent authority appointed by the Central Government as per their eligibility criteria.
- (ii) The Fees shall be as that for the Non Autonomous Government Institutes.

(6) Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to **candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only** subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(b) Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats of the total sanctioned intake of an institute, subject to a maximum of five (5) seats in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for Children of ex- service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1), Children of active service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2), Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State, or who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State or who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC examination from a school/college situated in the State of Maharashtra.

- (i) These seats are within the sanctioned intake and are available as **State Level seats**.
- (ii) A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 and DEF3 candidates shall be prepared.
- (iii) Candidates claiming these seats shall produce additional documents in Proforma C, D and/or E as applicable.
- (iv) This provision is NOT available to the children of **CIVILIAN STAFF** who is working /who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

(c) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake of all the Institutions under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates with following Disability.
